Dogs will have the opportunity of hunting up ground that holds rabbits as well as snipe, woodcock, pheasant and partridge. The ground is open with mainly white grass. Advice will be given on using the wind, reading the dog as well as handling at the point and flush with the emphasis on being steady to lifting birds and bolting rabbits. The day is open to dogs of all ages and stages and in particular novice dogs and novice handlers.

Handlers are advised to bring a wide collar and a long running line, light weight clothes line or similar, approximately 30ft long. Please be prepared to carry water and a bowl for the dog. Handlers are responsible for their own refreshments for the day. **The day will be limited to 12 dogs** which will be run in two groups. Preference will be given to HPRGA members.

**Dogs MUST be under control at all times and must be sheep safe.**
